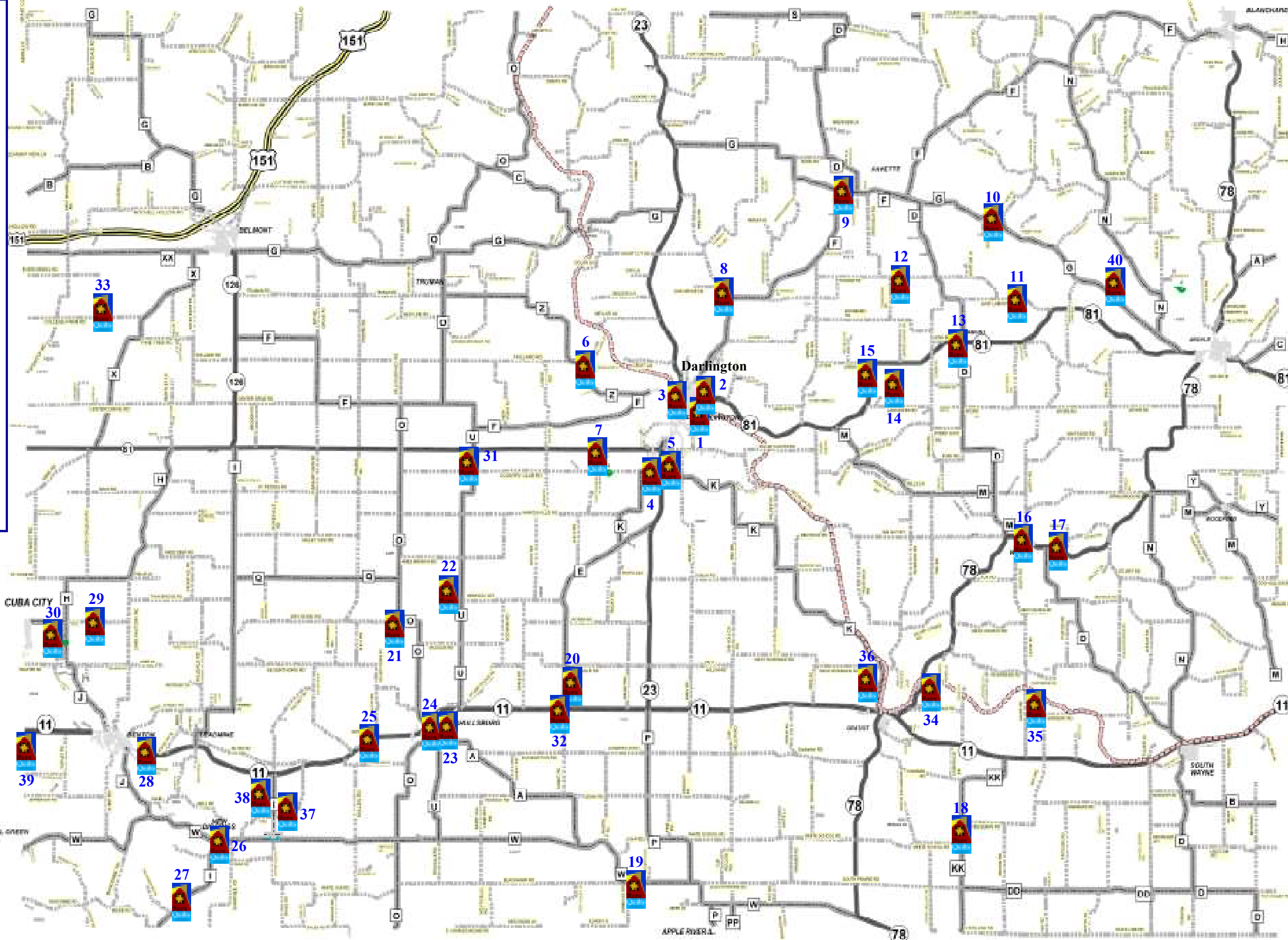



## We Need Your Help!

Barn Quilts of Lafayette County needs the help of community members who may be willing to donate their time, talent, funding or supplies. We are looking for neighbors willing to provide their expertise in construction, painting or quilt block design or who may be able to donate their time and lift equipment to hang the Barn Quilts on buildings.



Supplies needed include:

- 3/4” exterior plywood
- 10’ and 12’ treated 2x4s
- 1 1/2” and 5” screws
- Truss plates
- Latex exterior primer & paint (primary/secondary colors)
- Brushes
- Painting tape
- Ice cream or other containers for transferring paint.

Barn Quilts are colorful 8 foot square\* painted plywood quilt blocks mounted on barns or other buildings. The quilt blocks honor the art of quilting, celebrate our agricultural heritage, and help preserve the architecture and history of our local barns.

The idea originated in Ohio by Sue Ann Groves who wanted to honor her mother, an avid quilter. A “Clothesline of Quilts” has since spread throughout 22 states including Iowa, Missouri, New York, the Appalachian Trail states, and now, Lafayette County, Wisconsin!
